• The timetable has challenges to be completed during the time set for the subject.

Priorities for the year - things that ensure we get off to the right start:

- A growing ability to organise belongings.
- A willingness to listen and respond to instructions carefully.
- An aim to develop independence during the school day.
- Sharing books at home.

The only things that can be brought to school:

Names on belongings - please put names on everything worn or taken to school.
