Priorities for the year - things that ensure we get off to the right start:

- Developing the ability to look after personal belongings.
- Independence when getting changed or fastening laces.
- Self-organisation within the classroom by being able to settle quickly to a task.

The only things that can be brought to school:

Book bag Coat Water Bottle Packed lunch (if needed)

PE Kit – Please do not send PE kit in the first two weeks.

Names on belongings - please put names on everything worn or taken to school.

Additional Information related to safety after lockdown:

- Year 3 will start at 9.30am and finish at 3.30pm each day.
- Children will enter through the KS2 gate nearest to Fun Factory.
- Children will be collected from the KS2 playground. Adults should enter through the gate nearest to Fun Factory. Their child will walk across to meet them. The exit will be through the bottom playground gate.
- Hand sanitiser (non-ethanol) application and hand washing will be done frequently.
