- An enthusiasm for self-organisation and setting your own goals.

Additional Information related to safety after lockdown:

- Year 6 will start at 8.40am and finish at 2.40pm each day.
- Children will enter through the KS2 gate nearest to Fun Factory.
- Children will be collected from the KS2 playground. Adults should enter through the gate nearest to Fun Factory. Their child will walk across to meet them. The exit will be through the bottom playground gate.
- Hand sanitiser (non-ethanol) application and hand washing will be done frequently.
