Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope that this letter finds your family safe and well.

Following a period of time that has involved many challenges for everyone, we have received the government guidance about **fully opening school**. I am pleased to say that all children can return to school from Monday 8th March.

<u>Enclosed is information which I hope you will share with your child.</u> We have tried to keep things as familiar as possible within the limits of our risk assessment and will spend a lot of time focusing on their wellbeing and settling them back in to school life.

We will need to **continue with staggered start and end times** for the school day that we had last term. These are necessary to prevent large crowds at the gates and to maintain year group bubbles within school.

We are aware that this may create challenges for a small number of families. Please contact school if your family has **children who have start times that are 30 minutes or more apart and we will arrange a supervised space for them to wait within their year group**. The entrance for this provision will be the main door.

Newby Fun Factory will also reopen from the 8th March with limited availability due to their Covid risk assessment requiring them to limit numbers. Please visit https://newbyfunfactory.co.uk/ for details.
